by James Withers of Barbis County and Barbis laid
the receipt Whereof the said James Withers
have Received and in full for the said presents
I do engage and sell unto the said James Withers
five negroes named Tobias Virginia Long-
low Bob Leonard & have sold to the said
James Withers the said James Withers his heirs
Adminors and assigns forever To hold always
to the said James Withers and upon Condition that if the
said Stephen Clifford his Executors Adminors
or assigns shall at any time hereafter pay or cause to be
paid unto the aforesaid James Withers that sum
of Two hundred and Seventy three pounds Ten
Shillings with Lawfull Interest from the date
hereof or before the first day of February next
commencing the date hereof without any Deduction
or abatement out of the same then these presents
and every Article and Ventured here in contained
shall cease determine and be utterly void and
of none Effect any thing herein contrair to
the Contrary hereof In any wise Notwithstanding

Letter of Attorney from Mr. Richard Wright to Richard

Whereas I Richard Wright of James Island
in the Province of South Carolina am duly appointed
Administrator to All the goods and Chattels Defts &
Credits of my late beloved brother John Wright
