Wherever & Whatsoever to which I am entitled in Propriety or remainder,
to be equally divided among my said Nephews and Niece, Share and Share
alike to them and each of them absolutely and forever, And in Case of the
Death of either of my said Nephews or Niece before me, then his or her Share
herein bequeathed to Vest absolutely in the Surviving Child or Children of
Such deceased Nephew or Niece and in Case of no Child or Children Sur-
viving him or her, then the said Property to be bequeathed to Vest and Pass to
my said Surviving Nephews or Niece, And I do hereby Authorize and
Empower and it is my Will and desire and I hereby direct my Executors
hereinafter Named or Such of them as shall qualify, to Sell and Convey all
my said Estate real and Personal for a division and Settlement of said
Estate or for the purposes Contained in this Will. And Lastly I do hereby
Nominate and appoint my friend George Priest of Charleston Attorney
at Law and Charles Giese Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
