11. 13 State of South Carolina Charleston District. In the Name of God Amen. Know all Men by these presents That I Thomas Wigfall Sr do make this my last Will and Testament as follows to wit: 1st I request my Father will pay as far as he can my just and legal debt I may leave to save my memory from obloquy. 2^d I give and trust to my Executors hereinafter named all my right and title to and in my faithful Mulatto Woman Harriette and her three Children Thomas Harriette Clara, and Georgianna together with all the future

of the females, trusting that all the Kindness will be extended to them that their situation will permit. 3rd Jewish Thomas put to the trade of a House Carpenter as soon as fit for it. The Gals Jewish to remain under the charge of their mother. 4th Jewish Hannah to remain with her daughter Harriett the remainder of her life, and Simion and her son Samuel. They may have their time and be treated kindly in all respects. 5th All the household furniture including Bedding, Plate &c have been bought by Harriett at different times with money economically saved by her and to which I never laid further claim than the use of them as long as she lived with me. 6th Any property I may leave Jewish appropriated to the use of Harriett and her children by me. Lastly, I hereby nominate as my Executors my friends Wm Newton and J. C. Cochran and beg them both to Qualify

South Carolina, Charleston District. Codicil to the Will of Thomas Wigfall Jr. which will is dated the 14th November 1839. Upon more mature reflection upon the condition of my faithful Woman Harriett and to provide for the ultimate freedom of herself and three children Thomas, Clara, and Georgianna, I give and devise them to John J. Mercer and his successor and successors in Office as President of the Colonization Society to be delivered to S. J. Mercer.
