Know all Men by these presents That William Burt of Lynning in the County of Southampton in the Kingdom of Great Britain Merchant Master of the Good Ship or Schooner called the Bowley Galley lost at (his place) in Carolina in America am told and fully bound unto Thomas Ellory of Charles Town in South Carolina in the Province aforesaid Gentleman the Sum of Sixty and Twenty five pounds Sterling Money to be paid to the said Thomas Ellory his Certain Attorney Peter Adams or Assignee Towards payment well and lawfully made and I bind my self my Heirs Executors and Assigns for Done by these Presents sealed with my Seal and dated the Third Day of December Anno Domini 1729.

The Condition of this Obligation is Such That if the above bounden Burt his Heirs Executors and Assigns shall & lawfully Pay or Cause to be paid unto the above named Thomas Ellory his Executors or Assigns the full Sum of Sixty three pounds Sterling Money together with legall interest for the same on the first Day of February next ensuing the Day of the Date hereof in the Great Brittain or elsewhere in his Majesty's Dominions That then this Obligation shall be void Or else to be and remain in full force and Virtue.
