thirty seven Acres situate & being in Berkeley County
in the Province aforesaid & bounded & bounded to the
North East on the Land of George Benson to the South
East on Josephus Sound to the West on the Land of
Mary Mitchell & to the North West on the Land of
John Young together with the right titles Interest
Claim & Demand whatsoever w^{ch} I now have or w^{ch}
any or either of my heirs Ex^{ts} Administrators or
Assignes may hereafter have of to or in the said
Granted premises or any part thereof to have &
to hold the said Lands unto him the said Tho. Lorey
Jun^r his heirs & assigns forever, absolutely wth out
any manner of Condition as I the said Thomas Lorey
Jun^r have fully freely & absolutely, & of my own
accord sett & putt in further Testimony I do

To all to whom these presents
 Come from Spode & of Beekley County in
 Province of Georgia plain & clear

Whereas Thos^d William Spode by certain obligⁿ
 under my hand & Seal bearing Date of 22nd Day of
 1729 is held & firmly bound unto Isaac Holmes
 Charles Town in the Province afores^d much in the
 or penalty of one Thousand one hundred & forty
 four money in Condition thereunder written to
 his payment of the sum of Five hundred & Twenty
 five pounds, past or before the first Day
 February, next ensuing, the Date hereof, as by & of
 Obligation & Condition there of appears.

Now know ye that Thos^d William Spode for the more
 thane payment of the sum of five hundred & twenty
 pounds as also for the further consideration of the sum
 of five hundred & twenty pounds paid by Thos^d Isaac Holmes
 have given granted bargained & sold in plain & open
 market delivered & by these presents do fully &
 absolutely give grant bargain & sell & delivered unto Thos^d
 Isaac Holmes three Negro men named Cuffey Prince
 and Robin unto Thos^d Isaac Holmes his Ex^{rs} Adm^r
 assigns as his and their proper goods and chattels & to his
 & their own proper use benefit & behoof for ever...
 provided always and upon his Condition & Condition
 that if Thos^d William Spode or his Ex^{rs} Adm^r assigns
 of us Thos^d Isaac Holmes do well and truly pay or cause to be
 paid unto the afores^d Isaac Holmes his Ex^{rs} Adm^r
 Ex^{rs} Adm^r & assigns the afores^d sum of Five hundred
 & twenty pounds on & before the first day of the month
 ought to be paid according to the purport tenor
 and meaning of the said Obligation & Condition
 for Redemption of the before mentioned Negro slaves
 than this present Obligation & Condition for the redemption
 of the before mentioned Negro slaves then this present
 Obligation & Condition of bargain & sell and every thing herein
 contained to be utterly void & of no effect but if
 Default of payment of the sum of five hundred and
 twenty pounds be made by me Thos^d William Spode or
 part or in all or by my Ex^{rs} Adm^r or any of us at the
 time & to the same ought to be paid.

That Then and from then forth it shall and may
 be lawful to and for the said Isaac Holmes his Ex^{rs}
 Ex^{rs} Adm^r or assigns or any of them to have received &
