Whereas Thomas Robins Late of Charles Town in
this Province Deceased lately died intestate having
While he lived and at the time of his death several
Goods rights and Credits within the Province aforesaid
by means Whereof the full Disposition and Power of
granting the Dominion of all and singular the goods rights
and Credits of the said Thomas Robins Deceased and also
auditing the Receipts Calculations and Reckoning of
the said Dominion and a final Dismissal of the same to
me is manifestly known to belong knowing that the
goods rights and Credits of the said Deceased may be well an
fully administered converted and disposed of & hereby
Grant unto the said Francis Yonge in whose fidelity
in this behalf I very much confide full power by the
Tenor of these presents to administer the goods rights
and Credits of the said Deceased Which to him in his lifetime
and at the time of his death did belong and to ask collect due
revenue and receive the same and to pay the debts in which
the said Deceased stood obliged so far forth as the said Goods rights
and Credits will extend bearing unto their rate and value
of Laws being first sworn on the holy Evangelists of
Almighty God to make a true and perfect Inventory thereof
and to exhibit the same into the Secretary's Office in Charles
Town in order to be reviewed on or before the first Day of
March to come next ensuing and to render a Just and True audit
Calculation & reckoning of the said Dominion When the same
required

And forasmuch as the said Robert Johnson Esq
Yonge Minister of state in England the full rights and benefits
of the said Deceased

said Deceased which are or do remain within the said Parts and Places
which shall be shewn unto you by the said Francis Yonge and
then view and appraise all and every the said goods being first
sworn on the holy Evangelists of Almighty God to make a full &
perfect Inventory and appraisement and to cause the same
to be returned under your hand or any three or four of you into the
Secretary's Office in Charles Town in order to be recorded on or before
the first day of March to come next ensuing
