Negro Woman Household Goods & Working Tools &c. More all of my own
Property and Purchase before the Instaling her of & are hereby fully & freely
Declared & pronounced by me the Said Property & Purchase of the Said Joseph
Hurst his heirs & assigns for ever all Which I the Said Thomas Snow do for my
Self his Executors & Administrators Marant to Make good & Defend against the
Charges of all manner of Persons whatsoever unto the Said Hurst his heirs &c.
