To all to whome these presents shall come, Eliz^a Scriven
 of the City of London in the Kingdom of Great Britain, Relict of James Le
 Scriven, late of Charles Towne in the Province of South Carolina
 in America, Merchant, Dees Land Graveling. Whereas
 Earl of Brown Palatine, & the rest of the true & absolute Lords and
 Proprietors of the Province aforesaid, by their certain Deed or grant
 under the hands of their Deputy, & under the great Seal appointed
 for that purpose, bearing date the twenty second Day of March
 in the year of our Lord one thousand, six hundred & eighty two,
 did give & grant unto John Beresford of the Province of Carolina
 aforesaid Gent. One Towne Lott in Charles Towne aforesaid
 distinctly known in the map of the said Towne upon reason in the Survey
 General's Office by the Number forty three, & hitting & bounding as appears
 by a Certificate thereof to the said Grant annexed, To have & to hold
 the said Towne Lott to the said John Beresford his heirs & assigns
 forever, Yielding & paying therefor, to the Palatine & Lords Proprietors
 aforesaid, their heirs & assigns, as in & by the said Deed or grant,
 & entries in the registers Office of the said Province, Relation bearing
 thereunto had, & they may more fully & at large appear, &c.
 Whereas by several mean conveyances & assignments in the said
 Registry & registers Office in the registers Office aforesaid, the
 right, title, Interest, property & possession of and to the said Towne
 Lott N^o 43 became invested in the said James Scriven, late
 Deed in fee to him the said James Scriven his heirs & assigns
 forever. AND Whereas the said James Scriven being seized
 of the said Towne Lott N^o 43 did in his life time, viz^t on the twenty
 first Day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand six
 hundred ninety seven, make & put his last Will & testament
 in writing, under his hand & Seal, & therein & thereby amongst other
 things did constitute, appoint his Wife Eliz^a Scriven his
 sole heir, & did give & Devise unto her the said Eliz^a his whole
