No 10 of Charleston in the State of South Carolina being of sound mind memory
and understanding do hereby make my last will and Testament in man-
ner and form following; that is to say my body I commit to the Earth to be buried
at the discretion of my Executors herein after named - and as ^{regards} the property I may
possess my will is, that after the payment of my lawful debts, all the property
Estate publick stock, and effects whatsoever I may own at my death, of what
nature or kind whatsoever and wheresoever, whether real or personal, I do hereby
give grant and bequeath to Elizabeth Peter, Mary Peter and Lewis Peter my
children of color, duly emancipated by me according to the Laws of the said State
will appear on record in the Clerk of the Courts office at Charleston, share and share
alike, as tenants in common, to them their heirs Executors and Administrators or
assigns forever - it is however my will that my slave Betty who now stands
in that light, and is their mother, should not be ever sold by them or disposed
contrary to this my intention, but should be treated by them with every attention
and care in their power, under the guidance of my Executors herein after named
I do direct my Executors, to present to George W Eckhard attorney at law, my silver
watch with the chain, seal & Trinkets now annexed to it - the watch purchased
from Mr. Catherwood - this being presented to him as a mark of my regard for him
I do hereby appoint my friends George Kierlock and John C. Jones, Executors of
this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me made

and as a recompence for the trouble and attention they will bestow on the execution of this will I hereby give, to each of them, provided they qualify, or to him of said named executors who may qualify, the sum of two hundred Dollars - that is to say to Mr. Kinloch the sum of two hundred Dollars - and to Mr. Jones the sum of two hundred Dollars, subject to the above condition of their qualifying, over and above the lawful commissions. Hereby giving and granting to my said Executors power to sell and dispose of such property (excepting the city stock held by me in the city of Charleston) as they may conceive necessary or expedient - trusting to their best judgment in doing what they may find most to the advantage of my estate, and of those interested in it, as to its investment of the proceeds of such sale is. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this tenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three
