of this my last Will and testament made on this Nineteenth
day of October in the year of Our Lord One thousand Eight
Hundred and thirty nine and in the sixty fourth year of American
Independence

named as early as may be deemed expedient after my decease for
such prices as she may think proper and the proceeds therefrom be
invested in Public or Bank Stock at the discretion of my Executors
to be equally divided between my Wife Mrs Rosa S Schubr and our
Children Sarah Susan and Rosa Wilson their Executors Adm-
inistrators and assigns forever. And I hereby nominate constitute
and appoint my said Wife Mrs Rosa S Schubr my sole Executor
of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking any former
Will by me made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal in St. Georges Dorchester this the Eleventh day
of August in the year of Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and
thirty five and in the fifty ninth of the Independence of the
United States of America. Signed Sealed published and declared
by the said Wade Hampton Schubr as his last Will & Testament
in the presence of us who at his request and in his presence Witness
the same.
