

In the Name of God Amen / I William Daingerfield, knowing it is appointed for all men once to die, do make this my last Will and testament in manner and form following. 1st I bequeath my soul to Almighty God who gave it, and my body to be decently buried after Christian manner. 2^{ndly} My Will and desire is, that all my lawful debts and my funeral expences be first paid. 3^{rdly} I give and bequeath to my Nephew and Niece, Starline J. & Jane Daingerfield my woman Gloc and her future increase and Peter, my Plantation called Rivin, containing one hundred and twelve 1/2 Acres & also all my stock of horses, cattle, Hogs and all my goods and chattels whatsoever to them and their heirs forever, and lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my Brother James S. Daingerfield and John Daingerfield my Executors to this my last will and testament placing full confidence in them that they will execute every clause or part of this Will. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 17th of July in year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty two.
