N 3 Charleston 30th March 1840. I William S Elliott of City of
Charleston State of South Carolina do make this my last Will
being in bad and uncertain Health — I do hereby constitute
and appoint my Wife Anna Elliott my true & lawful Executrix
out of my property to pay all my just & lawful debts the balance
to be for the use of my Wife & Children. I give my fellow
Cudjoe — to my son William I do not wish him sold and
wish him well treated for his services to me. To my Grand
mother Mrs Margaret Savage I return the boy James given
by her to me, should she outlive me, if not he is to be kept for
the use of my Wife & Children and not to be sold on any
account as long as they live as he has been very faithful
to me in all my sickness and I value him & think he will
serve my family faithfully I also leave to be paid out
of my Estate the sum of Twenty dollars. Witness my hand and
seal at Charleston this thirtieth day of March Eighteen hun-
dred and forty, sixty fourth Year of the Independence of America
