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The State of South Carolina. In the Name of God Amen. I William Rivers of James Island, planter, being of sound mind, memory and understanding do make this my last Will and Testament, in manner following, that is to say. It is my will that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my death as practicable.

Item. It is my Will that all my Estate both Real and Personal be kept together by my Executors and Executrix hereinafter named for the use benefit and maintenance of my family until my youngest child which I may leave shall attain the age of 21 years or marry (except what is hereafter provided for my two daughters Georgianna and Eliza) and it is my will that my children receive the best education my estate will allow.

Item. It is my Will and Desire and I do hereby direct my Executors & Executrix, whilst my Estate is ^{so} kept together to pay annually to my Daughter Georgianna Burch the sum of one hundred Dollars.

Item. It is my Will and desire and I do hereby direct my Executors & Executrix to pay annually to my Daughter Eliza Rivers the sum of twenty Dollars so long as she remains in my family or under the roof where my Wife and younger children reside, but in case she quits there without the consent or deviation of my Executors and Executrix, I hereby revoke the said allowance.

Item. When my youngest child shall attain the age of 21 years or marry then it is my Will that my Estate both Real and Personal be sold at Public Auction and the proceeds thereof be appropriated as follows, that is to say

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Item. It is my Will that all my Estate both Real and Personal be kept together by my Executors and Executrix hereinafter named for the use benefit and maintenance of my family until my youngest child which I may leave shall attain the age of 21 years or marry (except what is hereafter provided for my two daughters Georgianna and Eliza) and it is my will that my children receive the best education my estate will allow.

Item. It is my Will and Desire and I do hereby direct my Executors & Executrix, whilst my Estate is ^{so} kept together to pay annually to my Daughter Georgianna Burck the sum of one hundred Dollars.

Item. It is my Will and desire and I do hereby direct my Executors & Executrix to pay annually to my Daughter Eliza Revis the sum of twenty Dollars so long as she remains in my family or under the roof where my Wife and younger children reside, but in case she quits there without the consent or direction of my Executors and Executrix, I hereby revoke the said allowance.

Item. When my youngest child shall attain the age of 21 years or marry then it is my Will that my Estate both Real and Personal be sold at Public Auction and the proceeds thereof be appropriated as follows, that is to say I give and bequeath unto my Executors and Executrix and the survivor of them the sum of Two thousand Dollars, in trust, to vest the same profitably and pay the interest thereof annually to my Daughter Georgianna Burck during the life of her Husband Edward C. Burck, to and for her

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sole and separate use; but if he should die leaving my said Son or Son-in-law
him, then we trust to pay over and transfer for the said sum of One Thousand
Dollars on the Stock or Bonds in which the same may be invested to my said
Daughter Georgianna as her absolute property free from all trust. But in
the event of my Daughter Georgianna dying leaving her Husband Edward
C. Burck surviving her, then it is my will that the Interest of the said
Thousand Dollars, be accumulated by my Executors and Administrators to the
Survivors or Survivor of them until the death of the said Edward C. Burck
at which time, it is my will that the said Two Thousand Dollars with
its accumulations be divided equally between the children of my said
Georgianna who may be living at the time then and share alike.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Executors and Administrators and the Sur-
vivors or Survivor of them the sum of one thousand Dollars, to be put to use
profitably and pay the Interest thereof annually to my Daughter Eliza Davis for and
during the term of her Natural life. And from and after her death then in trust
to pay the interest annually to my Daughter Georgianna Burck to and for her
sole and separate use during the life of her Husband Edward C. Burck, but
if he should be dead at the time of the death of Eliza or should die after-
wards leaving my Daughter Georgianna surviving him, then we trust
to pay over and transfer the said sum of One Thousand Dollars on the Stock
or Bonds in which it may be invested to Georgianna as her absolute
property free from all Trust. But if my Daughter Georgianna should die
before Eliza, then it is my Will, that after the death of Eliza the said
sum of One Thousand Dollars be divided equally between the children of my said

before Eliza, then it is my Will, that after the death of Eliza the said sum of one thousand dollars be divided equally between the children of Georgeanna, who may be living at the time share and share alike.

The rest and residue of my Estate I give and bequeath to my wife Susannah Ann Rivin and my children to whom I may have by her to be equally divided between them share and share alike. And if either of my said children die before my youngest child attain the age of 21 years or marry then the share of such child, I direct to be equally divided among my surviving children. Lastly I hereby nominate and appoint my friend John E Rivin and my two sons William Horace Rivin and Constant H Rivin Executors and my wife Susannah Ann Rivin Executrix of this my last Will and Testament.
