Maria her heirs and assigns forever the sum of seventeen
hundred and fifty dollars (3^d) Unto my son Thomas John
in trust for my daughter Ann Eliza the sum of twelve hundred
and fifty dollars as her dower for her issue. Should she die
without issue or her issue die without issue then her share to be
equally divided between my son Thomas John, my daughter
Maria and my son Thomas John in trust for my daughter
Charlotte Duriah Lawrence their heirs and assigns forever
4th Unto my son Thomas John in trust for my daughter
for my daughter Charlotte Duriah Lawrence the sum of
Seventeen hundred and thirty seven dollars 5th I do also
give devise and bequeath unto my son Thomas John his heirs and assigns

give devise and bequeath unto my son Thomas John in trust
for my daughter Charlotte Dinah Lawrence my female
servant Alice her issue Stephen and any other issue my
female servant Alice may hereafter have 6th I do also
give devise and bequeath unto my daughter Maria and
unto my son Thomas John in trust for my daughter Charlotte
Dinah Lawrence my third of a farm on Charleston Neck
belonging to the Estate of my deceased husband William
Price Young to be equally between them 7th I do also give
large Portrait of her Father William Price Young 8th I
do also give devise and bequeath unto my daughter Maria
the miniature likeness of her deceased brother William
Cox 9th I do also give devise and bequeath unto my
daughter Charlotte Dinah Lawrence the miniature like-
ness of her deceased Father William Price Young 10th I
do also give devise and bequeath unto my daughter Maria
one mattress one feather bed and two pillows 11th I do
also give devise and bequeath unto my son Thomas John
in trust for my daughter Ann Eliza all the furniture
and plate I have loaned her 12th All the residue rest
of Plate Household furniture &c. I do hereby give devise

and bequeath unto my son Thomas John in Trust for my daughter
Charlotte Dinah Lawrence 13th Should my daughter Charlotte
Dinah Lawrence die without will or without issue or her issue die
without issue then all the property which I have given devised and
bequeathed in trust for her shall be sold and divided among my
son Thomas John, my daughter Mariae and my son Thomas John
in trust for my daughter Ann Eliza and her issue 14th I do hereby
request my son Thomas John and my daughter Mariae Rebecca
to be as Parents to my daughter Charlotte Dinah Lawrence, and
to keep her with them so long as she remains unmarried

15th And I do nominate constitute and appoint my son Thomas
John and my friend Jacob Axon Executors of this my last will
and Testament hereby revoking and making void all and every
other will and Wills at any times heretofore by me made and do
declare this to be my last will and Testament In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this second day of
February in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred
and forty two

in manner following to wit (1) To my son Thomas John I give devise and bequeath all my Silver plates and China ware requesting him unless he should have any good reasons for otherwise disposing of them to bequeath them at his death to my Grandson William Gourdin Young (2) To my Granddaughters Martha and Ellen Johnson I give devise and bequeath one hundred dollars to be divided between them share and share alike (3) I give devise and bequeath to my son Thomas John in trust for my daughter Maria all the rest residue and remainder of the portion of my property devised to my said daughter Charlotte Emma Lawrence to be for the use of my said daughter Maria during her natural life and at her death to be disposed in the manner following to wit (a) To my son Thomas John in trust for my Granddaughter Mrs Catherine McElheran I give devise and bequeath the sum of six hundred dollars (b) To my son Thomas John in trust for my grandson Louis Gourdin Young I give devise and bequeath my servants Alice and Stephen and the future issue of said Alice (c) The rest residue and remainder of the property devised to my daughter Charlotte Emma Lawrence and at ^{during her natural life} her death to my daughter Maria to my grand children Louis Gourdin Young and Mrs Catherine McElheran to be equally divided between them share and share alike (d) Should my Granddaughter Mrs Catherine McElheran

die without issue then I give and bequeath the property above
devised in trust for her use to my Grandson Louis Gourdin
Young. And I do hereby declare this to be a Codicil to my
said Will which was made signed sealed and declared
on the second day of February in the year of our Lord One
thousand Eight hundred and forty two In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this seven teenth day
of October in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred
and forty two
