Debt inwards the said Deed good soleges so far forth as the said goods Rights &
Credits will come or according to their rate & order of dues being first to come
on the 29th day of May 1731 God to make a true and perfect Inventory

in order to be recorded on or before the first Day of November next ensuing
and to render a just and true account & Reckoning of this said Comon
