

Covenants & agreement for the better maintenance of the aforesaid Mary her issue & also for & in consideration of the sum of ten thousand pounds of the province aforesaid to the said W^m Bellinger & Mary his wife in hand paid by the said Daniel Donovan & Rich^d Fuller the said W^m Bellinger hereby acknowledged that the said W^m Bellinger with his wife have granted bargained & sold & in plain & open Delivered by by these presents do grant Bargain & sell & in open Market deliver unto the said Daniel Donovan & Rich^d Fuller all those the aforesaid two Negro men named Cuffey & Rand one Mustee Bayt Hercules, two Negro women Judy & Roxa two Indian Women Lucy & Jenny, & one Mustee Girl here To have and to hold the said Negro, Indian & Mustee together with their issue & increase unto the said Daniel Donovan & Rich^d Fuller their Ex^{ts} Adm^{rs} & Assignes for ever. 11/10/00 Special trust & confidence neverthelss & to the several uses be Intents & purposes hereinafter mentioned Specified, Declare (that is to say) upon special trust & confidence that they the said Daniel Donovan & Rich^d Fuller or either of them their or either of their Ex^{ts} Adm^{rs} for & during the term of the Natural of the said Mary the wife of the said William Bellinger pay & deliver all the interests & profits which shall arise & accrue by the labour & work of the said Negro Indian & Mustee into such person or persons as the said Mary by any writings hand whether she be sole or married shall appoint to or pay to her sole use benefit & behoofe AND upon this further trust & confidence that they the said Daniel Donovan & Rich^d Fuller or either of them their or either of their Ex^{ts} or Adm^{rs} for & after the Decese of the said Mary shall pay & deliver the interests & profits which shall arise or arise by the work & labour of the aforesaid Slaves & their increase together with the said Slaves & their increase unto such of the children of the said Mary as shall be begotten on her body by the said W^m Bellinger or to such other person or persons in such manner

as in such parts & proportions as the said Mary by any Deed or writing duly executed in her life time or by her last will & testament shall have appointed or for Default of such Limitation & Appointment then the said Daniel Donovan or Rich^d Fuller or either of them their or either of their Ex^{ts} or Adm^{rs} shall pay & deliver the interest & profits arising by the work of the said Slaves & their increase together with the said Slaves & their increase unto the children begotten on the body of the said Mary by the said W^m Bellinger equally to be divided among them & for Default of them then to W^m Bellinger — AND the said W^m Bellinger for himself his Ex^{ts} & Adm^{rs} doth covenant promise & Grant to & with the said Rich^d Fuller & Daniel Donovan their Ex^{ts} & Adm^{rs} in mannerly form following that he the said W^m Bellinger shall at all times hereafter permit & suffer the said Daniel Donovan & Rich^d Fuller or either of them their or either of their Ex^{ts} Adm^{rs} or Assignes to take have & receive the interest & profits arising or accruing by the work & labour of the aforesaid Negro, Indian & Mustee Slaves & to apply & dispose of the same to such uses & purposes in such manner as is herein before limited & appointed without the said W^m Bellinger or any other claiming by, from, or under him AND the said W^m Bellinger for himself his Ex^{ts} & Adm^{rs} doth covenant promise & Grant to & with the said Daniel Donovan & Rich^d Fuller their Ex^{ts} & Adm^{rs} that he the said W^m Bellinger shall at all times hereafter during the time the said Mary shall continue to be his wife permit & suffer her the said Mary freely & voluntarily to make such Appointment for the disposal of the interest & profits which shall arise by the work & labour of the aforesaid Slaves & their increase as to her shall seem meet & also shall permit & suffer her the said Mary to make such Appointment for the disposal of the interest & profits of the said Slaves & their increase together with the said Slaves & their Increase after her Decese in such manner as is herein before limited appointed mentioned

and declared by any deed or writing duly executed in full
 or by her last will & testament & that she the said W^m Bellinger
 shall not or will not use any threats, force, violence or
 do any other act whatsoever to hinder or prevent the said

It is now remembered by the presents that W^m Bellinger of Colleton
 in the province of South Carolina planter am held & firmly bound
 Daniel Donovan & Rich^d Fuller of Crutchen County in sh^{ire}
 for and planters in the full & purchase of one thousand five
 pounds current money of South Carolina to be paid to the said
 Donovan & Rich^d Fuller their Ex^{ors} or assigns to be
 well & truly to be made & done I do bind my self my heirs
 & assigns firmly by these presents sealed with my seal
 the eighteenth day of July anno dⁿⁱ 1727

Whereas there was a marriage lately had & solemnized between
 Keathon bounden to W^m Bellinger & Mary his wife lately called Mary
 Donovan & whereas it was agreed before the said marriage that the
 said Mary Donovan should have power & liberty to make her
 last will & testament during her lifetime & thereby freely to give
 bequeath & dispose of to such person or persons as she should think
 fit the said Mary was with two Negro men named Cuffey & Leander
 one mustee they called her with two Negro women Judy &
 Roxana two Indian women Lucy & Jenny one mustee girl quarter
 with their issue & increase then the condition of this obligation
 which that if the said W^m Bellinger do & shall permit & suffer her
 the said Mary his wife during her lifetime to make publish
 & declare her last will & testament in writing under her hand &
 seal duly executed & in the same to give & will bequeath or
 otherwise to dispose of at her free will & pleasure to such person
 or persons as she shall think fit all the for said slaves together
 with their issue and increase & further of the said W^m Bellinger
 his Ex^{ors} Admin^{ors} or assigns or any of them upon reasonable
 request to be made by any such person or persons for whom the
 said Mary shall so give or bequeath all or any of the for said
 slaves with their issue & increase do & shall well & truly deliver
 all or any of the said slaves & their increase to be given bequeathed
 as aforesaid by the said Mary & in what manner as shall be by her appointed
 & also if the said W^m Bellinger shall not nor will at any time
 hereafter oppose, obstruct, delay, or hinder the probate of any such
 will or writing purporting to be her last will & testament which
 shall so be made & executed by her the said Mary in the name
 herein before mentioned then this obligation shall be void of
 none effect or else shall be & remaine in full force & virtue
