I then Give and devise unto my said Son Thomas
and to his heirs & assigns forever all and singular
my Lands, Plantations, Tenements, Moveables, Slaves
and other my real & personal Estate

whatsoever

With my power and Whomever, upon Condition
provided nevertheless, that my said Son Thomas
or his heirs do and shall within One year
after my decease pay unto each & every of my other
Children, his brothers & sister, the sum of five hundred
Pounds a piece of good & Lawfull money of Great
Britain, and I do hereby Subject & Charge my
said real and personal Estate to & with the payment
thereof. I do hereby revoke all former & other Wills
by me at any time heretofore made, And I do publish
to declare this to be and stand as, and for my Last
Will & Testament. In witness whereof, I
have hereto set my Hand & Seal this 28th day
of September in the year of our Lord One thousand
Seven hundred & thirty One.

my use all debts, dues or demands, Sum or Sums of
money that may or shall become at any time
hereafter due to me, and moreover to appoint or
constitute Attorney or Attornies, one or more und^r them,
and at their pleasure to revoke and countermand the
same, giving and granting unto the^s Attornies my
full power and authority, by the tenour of these
Presents

premises as fully and in as ample a manner as if
I had been present, or had done it. In witness
