Such that if the above bound John Hilde his
heirs Exors or Admors shall & do well to pay
Pay or cause to be paid to the above named Gillson
Clapp his heirs Exors Admors or Assigns
the full & full sum of Five hundred &
three pounds fifteen shillings Current
money of the Province aforesaid at or upon the
first day of February next ensuing without
fraud or further delay then this Obligation to
be void & of no Effect or else to be and remain
in full force power & virtue

To all Christian people to Whom these presents
shall come William Maighie Sen^r of Charleston
in the Province of South Carolina Saddle and riding
know ye that I the said William Maighie Sen^r
Wife for the Love and Affection Which I have and
bear unto William Maighie Jun^r of Charleston
in the Province aforesaid also Saddle as for Divine
other good causes and considerations hereunto
moving have given and granted and for myself
my heirs Executors and Admors Do Give and Grant
unto the said William Maighie Jun^r my said Son
his heirs Executors Admors and Assigns All

my Estate to the said and personal whatsoever that
 I am any ways possessed of, interested in or Intitled
 unto within the said Province of South Carolina
 or in any other Province, of what nature quality or
 Condition soever the same may be, Whether the same
 Consist of Lands Tenements, Slaves household furniture
 Shop Goods Saddlery Tools or any other Goods or
 Chattels whatsoever pertaining in anywise
 belonging to me the said William Maaghe Senior
 in whose hands Custody and keeping soever the
 same may be in the said Province of South Carolina
 or elsewhere To have hold use and receive of
 possess and enjoy the same unto my said Son
 William Maaghe Junr his heirs & assigns forever
 Without any manner of Claim
 Challenge or demand whatsoever, by any form
 or persons whatsoever. Excepting Nevertheless
 and it is the true Intent & meaning of this present
 that the said William Maaghe Junr my said Son
 shall and is hereby obliged to maintain and
 William Maaghe Junr in me at Drink Washing
 Dying & appparell during the Term of my life
 agreeable to an Obligation under this hand and
 Seal to me bearing even date with these presents
 relation being thereunto had may more fully appear
 And I the said William Maaghe Senior the said
 bargained premises to the said William Maaghe
 Junr his heirs & assigns forever & also in so that an
 Writ Warrant & forever defend by these presents
 In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand and Seal this 18th day of March in the
 fifth year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George
 the second by the Grace of God of Great Britain
