that I the said William Marthon of the parish
of St. Bartholomew in the County of Colchester
Planter for and in consideration of Love Good
Will and Affection which I have and do bear
towards my Loving Son and Daughter
William and Margaret Little both of the same
Parish and County Planter and Spinster given
and Granted and by these presents do freely
fully and absolutely Give and Grant unto
the said Will and Margaret Little their Heirs
Executors or assigns all and Singular Two hundred
Acres of Land of ye Plantation which I now live
upon one Negro man named to be Sir Cove and
Calfs One Moore and Calf now being in my
present possession in the Parish aforesaid.
Known by the name of Pon Pon of which
with these present I have Delivered him and
for the said William and Margaret Little my
Inventory signed with my own Hand and
bearing even date to have and to hold all the
said two hundred Acres of Land and Negro man
and Cove and Calfs Moore and Calf in the
said premises or at Dwelling house where to
them the said William and Margaret Little
their Heirs &c. Administrators from hence
forth as his and hers and their proper Land
Negro and Calfs Moore and Calf absolutely
without any manner of Condition in Witness
whereof I have hereunto set my Hand
and Seal this 26 day of January in the fifth

These may Certify that Mr. Charles
 Brown Collector of his Majesty's Customs for Port
 Royal in this Province four line day before
 me and did take the Oath mentioned in
 a Statute made in the first year of the late
 King William Intituled an Act for
 obligating the Oaths of Allegiance and
 Supremacy and appointing other Oaths
 and did then and there make & subscribe
 the Declaration mentioned in a Statute
 made in the 25th Year of the late King
 Charles the Third Intituled an Act for
 preventing Dangers that may happen
 from popish Recusants and that what
 he did there and then is Registered according
 to the Act first above mentioned And
 also the Oath De Fideli for due Execution
 of the Office given under my hand the
 last of the day of May 1792 and in the fifth
 Year of his Majesty's Reign
