rection or management of any husband of the said Laura
Kelly. And upon the death of the said Laura Kelly then
In trust to and for such further and other uses intents and
purposes as she the said Laura Kelly by her last Will and Testa-
ment executed in the presence of one or more credible witnesses
shall or may limit, direct and appoint of and concerning the same. I

108. to my half sister Mrs. Elizabeth Kelly I give one shilling. I give all the rest residue of my Estate Real and Personal and my and my deceased husband's fund I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Caroline M. Nisbett her heir, Executors and administrators forever. Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my said daughter Caroline M. Nisbett to be the sole Executrix of this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hands and seal this eighth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Seventeen and forty seconds of American Independence.
