 ful of my mortality do this 26th day of October in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty
 five make and declare this to be my last Will and testa-
 ment revoking all others heretofore made. First I de-
 sire to be decently and privately buried, also I give
 to my Wife Catharine Foxworth and my son Francis
 William Foxworth the whole of my property both real and
 personal for their joint uses during the term of their
 single life or my Sons Minority. Also I desire that should
 my Wife Marry, the negro girl Martha shall be given to
 her in lieu of dower and the rest of my property to my
 son if he be alive. Also I desire that my aged Mother
 be supported out of my property but that no part thereof
 shall be sold or detached for that purpose. Also I de-
 sire if my son shall die under age or before he marries
 that all his property shall revert to my Wife if she be
 alive and single, but if she be married or dead in that
 case I desire that his property be given to my Brother
 Stephen Hening and the lawful heirs of his body. Also I
 desire that if my brother die and his children do not ar-
 rive at the years of maturity, then and in that case I
 desire that the property shall be given to Robert Lewis
 Foxworth the son of Stephen Foxworth (generally called
 Little Stephen) Also I desire that whenever my son shall
 arrive at the age of Twenty one years he shall be at lib-
 erty to take off his portion of the property which shall
 be all that I possess except the girl Martha before men-
 tioned All the rest and residue of my property or estate
 whatsoever & Wheresoever to be found and not hereinbefore
 mentioned I do give and bequeath to my Wife Catharine F.
 Foxworth and my son Francis W. Foxworth. And I do hereby

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constitute and appoint my wife Catharine F Foxworth my Executrix and my friends Robert Lewis Foxworth and Doctor John J Couturier Executors to this my last will and testament.
