bequeath to my Wife Sarah Allan my sons Richard Allan and  
Robert Mackeron Allan my Daughters Mary Kerr Allan and Sus-  
san Mackeron Allan share and share alike equally divided  
of all I may die possessed. And I hereby appoint my said  
Wife Sarah Allen my Executrix to this Will and my son Rich-  
ard Allen Executor to the same likewise my son Robert Mack-  
eron Allan an Executor to the same when he shall arrive  
at lawful age. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my  
Hand and Seal this twenty <sup>#1</sup>three and in the forty Seventh  
year of American Independence.
