mind do make publish and declare this my Last Will and tes-
tament in manner and form following that is to Say. Im-
promis I will and direct all my just debts & funeral ex-
pences to be paid as soon as may be convenient after my
death. Item I give & bequeath all my plate Jewels Clothes
and furniture unto my dear grand Daughter Amelia Tilghman
Walton forever. Item whereas I have on the day of the date
of this my Last Will and testament entered into and duly
executed a covenant and agreement with my Son in Law Wil-
liam Walton the father of the above named Amelia Tilghman
Walton, and husband of my dear Daughter Justina Louisa
Gennerick that in consideration among other things of the
covenant and agreement by him with me made and the con-
veyance by him to me of all his right interest title Cur-
tesy demand and claim of in and to all and Singular the
property real and personal belonging to the estate of my
dear deceased Husband John Frederick Gennerick to and for
the Several uses & purposes in the said Covenant and Con-
veyance fully set forth and to which deed of covenant and
conveyance bearing even date herewith I do hereby Special-
ly refer and direct and require that the several trusts and
uses therein set forth shall be taken to be and contain
a part of my Last Will and Testament and in pursuance of
my said Covenant and agreement I do hereby give devise &
bequeath all the rest residue and remainder of my estate
real and personal whatsoever and wheresoever unto my dear
daughter Justina Louisa Walton to and for her own Sole and
Seperate use benefit and behoof and subject to all and

Singular the several and same uses intents and purposes and to and for the several and same uses and trusts as are specially set forth expressed and declared of and concerning the property real and personal coming to her the said Justina I. Walton at my death from her fathers Estate in and by the said deed of Covenant and conveyance of this date between me and the said William Walton and for no other use trust intent or purpose whatever and without being in any manner subject to the Debts contracts Contreoul or engagements of any husband whom she may have. Lastly I constitute nominate and appoint my son in Law William Walton my good friend Thomas Flemming Executors and my dear daughter Justina Louisa Walton Executrix of this my Last Will & testament hereby revoking and annulling all former and other wills by me heretofore made and ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my Last Will and testament.
