Charleston S.C. June 21st 1821 In the Name of God Amen. I Andrew Hasell as my Last Will and Testament hereby nominate constitute and appoint my beloved Wife Hannah Hasell Executrix and John Ashe Son Doctor Paul Whiston and Robert Quash Executors of my own Estate & Doctor Paul Whiston and Jacob B. Son Executors of my Brothers Estate.

Codicil. Charleston S.C. 25 September 1821. The only change which is made to the above Will is substituting the name of Jacob B. Son as Executor to my Brothers Estate instead of Daniel B. Son as originally written having been done when I was very low and my memory bad not that for a moment do think my worthy friend Webb would not do every thing for the Estate but it was my original intention to have appointed my friend Son if I had not the power of nominating Executors to that Estate my friend Doctor Whiston I hope will administer on the same my wish is as it regards my own property that it be equally divided between my Wife and Children my Wife having the use of the whole as long as they continue minors or unmarried upon either of which events their becoming of age or marrying they are then to have their proportion paid them but should my Wife again marry then my Executors to pay her her proportion of the Estate and keep the children in their hands for their support and benefit until they become of age or marry it is hoped it may be tested in the best manner and now having finished

not the power of nominating Executors as was the case with
Western I hope will Administer on the same my wish is as it regards
my own property that it be Equally divided between my Wife and Children
my Wife having the use of the whole as long as they continue minors or unmar-
ried upon either of which events their becoming of age or marrying they
are then to have their proportion paid them but should my Wife again marry
then my Executors to pay her her proportion of the Estate and keep the children
in their hands for their support and benefit until they become of age or marry
it is hoped it may be Writed in the best manner and now having finished
my worldly concerns I Commit my Soul and Body to the Great Author
of my being trusting in the merits of his Son our Saviour Jesus Christ that
he will have mercy upon me in that world to which I am hastening
