ANN LANGFORD

17 R.<sup>o</sup> In the Name of God Amen. I ANN R Langford of  
N<sup>o</sup> 8 Charleston Widow do make and declare this to be  
my last Will and testament hereby revoking all former  
wills by me made. First I desire my body to be buried in  
the Baptist burial ground in Church Street. Secondly I  
give devise & bequeath unto Ann Godet in consideration of  
her Kind attention to me in my old age my lot of Land in  
Liberty street Charleston and all the Buildings thereon  
for and during the term of her Natural Life and from and  
after her death I give devise and bequeath the Said Lot  
and buildings unto the Baptist religious Congregation or  
Society worshipping in the Baptist Church in Church Street  
Charleston by Whatever name of Incorporation they have in  
Law and to their successors and assigns forever. Thirdly  
I give and bequeath unto the said Ann Godett all the rest  
residue and remainder of my estate to her and her Executors  
administrators and assigns forever. Lastly I Nominate and  
appoint the said Ann Godett and the Rev<sup>d</sup> Dr. Furman Execu-  
trix and Executor of this my Last Will and testament. Wit-  
ness my Hand 1st July 1825.-- Ann Langford (LS)
