

N. 25. In the name of God Amen. I Barber/Smith of Charleston
District State of South Carolina, being sick and weak in body, but
^{sound} of perfect memory and judgment and knowledge, that it is ap-
pointed by Almighty God for all Persons to die do make and
ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form
following to wit. Imprimis I give my soul to the disposal of
the Almighty God who gave it and certain hope of his pardon
and acceptation through his mercies and the merits of his be-
loved Son my blessed Savior and Redeemer the Lord Jesus Christ
and my mortal body I recommend to the care of my Executors here-
after named to be interred at their discretion in the burial place
of Christian ^{burial} and respecting such worldly goods as it has pleased God to
bless me with in this life I leave them to be disposed of by my Executors
as follows. Imprimis it is ^{my} will and desire that my youngest Son
that is to say Charles Smith which I give and dispose bequeath
one hundred Dollars to be paid him on his arriving to the age of Twenty
one years I do also give and bequeath unto my grandson Wm
Smith being a Son of my Son Jacob Smith of which said Grand-
Son I do give and bequeath one Heifer yearling. I do also give
and bequeath unto my aforesaid Son Charles Smith a small
stock of Hogs and the provisions which I have now present-
ly and it is now my Will and desire that after my death that
the remainder part of my estate be sold at Public Sale and the
proceeds thereof be equally divided between my Son Jacob Smith and my Son Charles Smith.

Smith and my son Charles Smith. And lastly I do appoint
Harvey and James Harvey Executors to this my last Will and Testa-
ment and hereby revoking all former Wills whatever and wholly
disallowing and disannulling them and constituting this as my last
Will and Testament: in witness whereunto I have set my hand and
seal this the sixteenth day of November in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and eighteen.
