In the Name of God, I Benjamin Reynolds of John's Island make this my last Will and testament. I resign my soul to its Creator in all humble hope of its future happiness as in the disposal of a Being infinitely just; and my body to be buried at the Church at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named, and my property to be disposed of as follows first, the property I have already given my Children tho' perhaps not equal yet I hope and trust they will be satisfied therewith. The plantation I now live on I give to my two Daughters Emily and Cornelia the dividing line to run an equal distance between the landing path and the Canal and another parallel line to begin where the said landing path turns off to go round the buildings and that line when made shall run from the River up to the Ferry road and thence across old Toms field up to the edge of the Swamp, thence along the edge of the Swamp, westward to the line of the Estate of Gibbs, and all that body of Land lying west of the Said line I give to my daughter Emily, and all the lands lying eastward of said line I give to my Daughter Cornelia to them and their heirs forever. And I further give to my Daughter Cornelia twenty negroes of which Cretia and her family Shall make a part, and old Tony I leave to her care but not as a Slave, but one who has been faithful to me in the war of the revolution, and the above said negroes when so counted off by my Executor I give to her and her heirs forever. And after the full payment of my debts, my will is that the residue of my Estate shall be equally divided between the Children of my deceased Son and my Daughter Mary Elizabeth, Emily and Cornelia or their Children (each taking that portion their parent would have entitled to if alive) to them and their heirs forever. But my Executor shall give to my Daughter Cornelia out of the Stock 6 head

of Darien and 32 of Beaufort were my trust before my last option
and no trustee shall be appointed between my will & my daughters
no trust given, and my two Williams children shall go to
John Benjamine and my heirs from his George Stevens and my
sons of Darien to their spouses. I appoint Forrest & Doro-
thea Dorothea Stevens to take up their will & Dorothea and
in case of the death of either husband from I appoint
George & Anna Stevens to manage the same. This is my will
written with my hand and sealed under seal of attorney

I do hereby stipulate this my will and make it the witness. That if I die before I appoint an one of my trustees. That trust of land called Broadwater begin
at the road to Wilson and beginning at the foot of Hol-
lywood Bridge Within I was obliged to take in being the
portion of enough to Broadwater I called the the following
dimensions to 4000 ft wide by 100 ft long, paying back to River
Benton about one acre on the back of the bridge as
Broadwater paid to me and the balance you are to pay to
the back of the bridge and in 1824 remunerating my other
descents would have no power of interference. Since no
one will be served I remunerate to the Broadwater above all-
otted to with except that portion of said land lying to
the amount of one hundred acres and more to keep and use
that part of land which I have possessed of all my life
for my own use except the better of my estate are fully
paid off I have will out of the said Broadwater and will
my heirs upon the world last for three years after the time
of the will of said Broadwater to take nothing else

free of incumbrance by an agreement between us that he would provide for those who were born and I for those that may come and this is doing but common justice to my younger Daughters and their Husbands Capⁿ Jenkins and Benjⁿ F Scott and having the utmost confidence in them as Executors and Genⁿ I am fully satisfied they will give up the Estate reserved by me as soon as they have done justice to themselves. This is my Will one entire will written with my own hand and dated the 20th ~~May~~
1826.
