 State of South Carolina, In the County of Charleston I, Charles Frisch,
 do hereby with a sound & disposing mind, memory & understanding
 make my last Will and Testament, in manner & form follow-
 ing... First I commend my soul to God who gave it, and
 my Body I consign to the Earth, to be buried with a
 decent Christian like funeral at the discretion of my Executors
 hereinafter named. — First, It is my Will & desire, that the
 expenses of my Funeral, as well as all my just debts and
 lawful demands against my Estate, shall be fully paid &
 satisfied by my Executors, as soon as it can conveniently
 be done after my decease, Item I give, devise & bequeath
 to my Wife Elizabeth Frisch, my House and lot No. 263
 on the east side of King Street, all my Household and Kitchen
 or Furniture, all my Wearing Apparel, & all such goods, wares
 and merchandises in my Shop and out Buildings, as shall
 belong to me at the time of my decease to have and to hold
 the same and each and every part thereof to her the said
 and assigns forever. — Item I order & direct that my Execu-
 tors shall cause my Negroes slaves to be sold at Public Auction
 for cash

284 In cash, except my Negro Boy Brutus. One of my Negro
Women, whom my Wife may choose from among the number
of my slaves. The said Boy Brutus and the Negro Woman
to be chosen aforesaid shall belong to my Wife and to
her Heirs and Assigns forever & the said Negro Woman
hath also then to me belonging. One child of each of you
shall also be the property of my Wife; Provided however
that my said Wife shall and doth within two weeks after my
decease, give a Receipt to my Executor for the delivery of
the said Boy Brutus & of the Negro Woman with one of her
children, chosen by her as aforesaid. In case my Wife
should refuse or neglect to give such receipt to my Executor
within two weeks after my decease, he shall cause all
and every of my Negroes to be sold for cash at public
Auction, and my Wife shall thereby forfeit all right and
claim to the aforesaid Negroes and any or either of them
them. I order & direct, that my Executor shall pay over
to my Wife & her abeth Heirs, the net proceeds arising
from the sale of my slaves as aforesaid. - Item. It is
my Will & desire that if the neat proceeds arising from
the sale of my Negro Slaves, should be less than six thousand
Dollars, My Executor shall thereafter pay to my Wife
from other funds of my Estate as much money as will

my Will & desire that if the neat proceeds arising from
the sale of my Negro Slaves, should be less than six thousand
Dollars, My Executor shall thereafter pay to my Wife
from other funds of my Estate as much money as will
be required to make up for her the full amount of
six thousand Dollars-- Item it is my Will and desire
and I do hereby declare, that the foregoing Gifts, desires
& Requests to my Wife Elizabeth Trisk shall be in
Lieu of her Dower, & thirds, and a full satisfaction for
all and any claims & demands which she may have or
pretends to have in to or against my Estate on any account
whatsoever-- Item It is my Will & desire, that if my Wife
Elizabeth Trisk should die before me, all what I had
intended to give her in and by this my last Will and
Testament, shall belong to the Children of my Sister in
Germany hereinafter named, except my House and Lot in
King Street, which premises shall in such case be subject
to the free and absolute disposal of my Executor--
Item it is my Will and desire, that if my Wife Elizabeth
Trisk should die after me, but before she receives the full
Amount of Six thousand Dollars left to her as aforesaid
the said sum or so much thereof, as had not been received
by her in her life Time, shall belong to my Sister in

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Germany herein after named. I do hereby give & devise the same to the
Resident of my Estate, whatsoever Whencever the same may
be, I do hereby give & devise the same to the children of
my Sister Carolina Dague & to the Son of my Deceased
Sister Elizabeth Ditz, to be divided among them in five
equal parts share & share alike. And in order to put my
said Sister Children in possession of their portion of my
Estate as soon as possible, I do hereby authorize my
Executor to sell my Bank Stock and to collect my
outstanding Debt without delay, and to remit the
Amount thereof from time to time to my nephews &
to the Husbands of my nieces living at Eickelburg or
in the vicinity thereof near Weinsburg in the Kingdom
of Wurttemberg. Lastly, I do hereby nominate, constitute
& appoint my Friend Mr. Christian Henry Taber as
Executor of this my last Will and Testament giving
him full and absolute power to arrange & settle the
affairs of my Estate according to his Judgement and
discretion, and discharging him free from all responsi-
bility for any loss or delay, that may take place
with regard to the remittances, which he is to make to my
Sister Children in Germany. And I do hereby revoke & declare
null & void all other former Wills & Testaments, by
