Eckhard Two thousand dollars. I bequeath to my
Niece Mr^s Priscilla Perkins of Camden Two thou
sand dollars for the use and benefit of the children
she now has and may hereafter have I bequeath
to Miss Elizabeth Pouchmeyer one thousand dollars
and to Mr^s Juliana Griggs one thousand dollars.
The rest and residue of my property I give & bequeath
to the Lutheran Church of German Protestants at the
corner of Archdale and Clifford Streets. I do give
my Executor authority to sell said property what
I own for the purpose of effecting a division and
carrying into effect this my will. As to the servants
Benjamin William Luce and her three children and
such as may hereafter be born in consideration of
their fidelity and devoted attention to all of my fa
mily both living and dead and not wishing them
by a stranger I hereby give them to my Executor
and friend Daniel Hurlbeck to hold said slaves

as his property satisfied that he will deal liberally and
kindly with them and not require of them high wages
which I hereby direct shall be paid to the said Lutheran
Church of German Protestants I authorize my Executor
if he at any time may think it advisable or if he cannot
make it convenient to hold said slaves for the purpose
stated to sell said slaves at Public or private sale
to insure a kind master and one whom they may
select I request him not to require a high but a very
moderate and low price and in such event he is to
pay the proceeds of sale to said Church I will that my
Executor is not to be held responsible for loss of price
of sale or of the wages of said negroes and he is to allow
them what he thinks proper for their support
