 make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner

 and Eugene P. O'Reilly all my real estate to be equally di-
 vided between them for their education and maintenance.
 I give and bequeath to my eldest Daughter Elizabeth Mary
 O'Reilly all my Personal Property consisting of my silver
 plate Household furniture cloathing bed and table linning
 &c &c providing there should be no real estate when the
 affairs of the Estate of my late much lamented Husband
 James O'Reilly is Settled. Then it is my will that all my
 personal property shall be equally divided between the
 three above mentioned children and Lastly I give and be-
 queath to my dear son James Thomas O'Reilly one Holy Bible
 he being previously provided for by a liberal Education,
 and I hereby appoint my two friends William Waller and
 John S Bird my Executors of this my Last Will and Testa-
 ment hereby revoking all former wills by me made. In
