thereon forty five feet seven Inches and on the
Back line forty six feet & in depth One hundred
and twenty six feet three Inches bounded East-
wardly by the No 18 as represented in a plat belonging
to the Charleston College Southwardly by lot No 16
Southwestwardly by lot No 16 - Item after the Death
of my aforesaid Wife I give and devise all my personal
and Real Estate aforesaid to my Children to wit -
Benjamin L. Huger, Francis Huger Carlos Huger,
James Huger, John Huger, Mary Huger Ann Huger
Diannah Huger and Eliza Huger to be enjoyed
by them as Tenants in Common and not as Joint
Tenants And not to be sold or disposed of by them
or either of them or any pretence whatever and

by them as Tenants in Common and not as Joint
Tenants And not to be sold or disposed of by them
or either of them on any pretence whatever and
lastly I do hereby Appoint My Son Benjamin J.
Huger to be my sole Executor for the fullfillment of
this my last Will & Testament and further more I do
hereby Appoint my said Son Benjamin J. Huger Trustee
& Guardian of my Minor Children, now living and an-
nulling all former Wills by and heretofore made ratifying
and Confirming this and none other to be my last
Will and Testament - In Testimony whereof I have
hereunto set my hand this fifteenth day of October
In the Year of Our Lord one thousand Eight hundred
