In the Name of God Amen. I Charles Tew of the City of Charleston & State of South Carolina (instructor of youth) being of sound mind and perfect memory, blefseed be almighty God for the same, do make and publish this my last Will and testament in form following, that is to say I give & bequeath unto my beloved Wife Eleanor Tew the premises that I now occupy Situate in Wentworth Street on the north side containing twenty four feet six inches in front on said Street and one hundred and forty five feet in depth on land of Mr Ferguson, bounded to the East on the premises of William Graham and to the West on the premises of Elizabeth Morgan together with all the improvements thereon, likewise all silver plate, household and Kitchen furniture Beds or Bedding money of any description and any other articles that I may be pofsefseed of at the time of my decease, during her natural Life (money excepted) upon this Exprefs condition that she pay to my two children Eleanor Hornby & Thomas Richard Tew each the one third of the rent of the premises beforementioned after the deducting the necessary expences that may accrue on the same, after their arrival (the former at the age of Eighteen and the latter ^{one} of twenty/years and should my said Wife Survive both my Children then the said property to be entirely at her disposal but on the contrary whatever may remain to be equally divided between them or to the survivor. And I do hereby appoint my said beloved Wife Eleanor Tew sole Executrix of this my last and only Will and testament also my friends Doctor Joseph Johnson and James Jervey Esquires to be her counsellors.
