man named Sackey. I give to my Granddaughter Constantia
Waring, my negro woman named Maria, also Mary & her two
children Isaac & Sarah, Martha, Betty & David, also my negro man
named Botto & his wife Bess, & Walter, & his son James, also
my waiting man named Syke, & my negro woman called Black
Mary together with the issue & increase of all & every of the females
of the said Slaves to be born after the date of this my Will, and I leave
all my Household & Kitchen furniture, plate, linen, & dressing ware,

204. Beds, Bedding, Bedlinen and a Table Linen, except one Table
Bed & Mattress which I give to my Grand Son John Ashby
Wigfall. Item. I give to my Grand Son Thomas Wigfall
a Boy named Minos and a negro man named Paul. Item
I give to my grandson Samuel Wigfall my negro man
named Butler and my negro man Lucas. Item. I give to my
grandson William Moore Wigfall, Samuel's two children Guy &
Mary, with the future issue of Mary to be born after the date
of this my Will. Item. I give to my Grand Daughter Sarah Wig-
fall my negro woman Amelia & her two children Isabel &
John, together with the future issue & increase of the females to
be born after the date of this my Will. Item. I give to my
Grand Son Edward Wigfall my negro woman named Doll
& her two children Peter & Dianna, together with the future
issue and increase of the females to be born after the date of this
my Will. Item. I give devise and bequeath all such parts & por-
tions of the Estate, both real & personal of my late daughter Ca-
tharine Lubbock, deceased, to which I am entitled, to and amongst
all my grandchildren, their Heirs, Executors, administrators &
assigns forever, Share & Share alike. Item. It is my Will, notwith-
standing any thing herein before contained, that my Son Thomas
Wigfall, his Executors & administrators shall have the use of the
personal Slaves & their issue herein bequeathed to him in his

said Slaves & their issue herein bequeathed to such of my Grand
Children respectively as are under age & unmarried free of any
charge for wages or hire until my ^{Grand} Children shall severally
arrive to the age of Twenty one years or be married; he or they
my said Son, his Executors or administrators, during the said time
clothing & maintaining the said Slaves, & paying their Taxes and
all other necessary & incidental Expenses. And in case any of my
said Grandchildren shall die under age & unmarried the Slaves
or other property given devised and bequeathed as aforesaid, to him or
her then so dying, shall be equally divided between and amongst
the Survivors of my said Grandchildren, and the Issue of such of
them as may be dead, such Issue taking the share which the parent
would have been entitled to if alive. Item I give devise and
bequeath all the rest residue and remainder of my Estate,
both real & personal whatsoever, & whatsoever to my Son Thomas
Wigfall, his heirs, Executors, administrators & assigns forever And
I appoint my said Son sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament
hereby revoking all former Wills by me made. In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & seal the sixteenth day of January in the year
of our Lord One thousand eight hundred & eighteen.
