

Warrant to appraise the goods of Peter Wallis.

all such parts and places within this Province as you shall
be directed to by Peter Wallis Widow Administratrix of the
goods & Effects of Peter Wallis Late of St James Santa
Planta Decd wheresoever any of the goods of the said Decd are
or do remain within the said parts or places which shall be
shown to you by the said Peter Wallis and there view and appraise
all & every the said goods being first sworn on the holy Evangelists
of Almighty God to make a full & perfect Inventory or appraisal
and to cause the same to be returned under your hand or any
three or four of you into the Secretaries office in Charleston
in order to be recorded on or before the first day of January
next ensuing.

to be Levied and Collected his Majesty's Customs Duties and other
duties in that part of Great Britain called England
Hall by authority of the right Hon^{ble} the Lords Commissioners
of His Majesty's Treasury and in pursuance of His Majesty's
Commission under the great Seal of Great Britain to us in that
behalf Deputed and Empowered and Do hereby Depute and empower
George Chalby to be Searcher of all the rates Duties and impositions
arising and growing due to his Majesty at Charleston in South
Carolina in America by virtue whereof he hath power to
enter into any ship Bottom Boat or other vessel as also into
any Shop House warehouse hothouse or other place whatsoever
to make diligent Search into any French Chest Pack Case Trunk
or any other parcel or package whatsoever for any goods wares or
merchandise prohibited to be imported or exported or whereof the Customs
or other Duties have not been duly paid and the same to seize to his
Majesty's Use and also to put in Execution all other the lawfull statutes
and authorities for the managing or Collecting the said Duties in
all things proceeding as the Law directs wholly paying and requiring
all & every his Majesty's Officers and ministers & all others whom it
may concern to be aiding and assisting to him the said Chalby in
all things as becometh Given under our hands & Seal at the
Customs House on the twenty fifth
day of June in the fifth year of the reign of our Sovereign
Lord King George the Second Anno Domini 1731
