do make and publish this my last Will and Testament hereby
revoking all others. I give and bequeath unto my Son Charles
William D'Oysey all the Estate whatever, which I may die pos-
sessed of both real and personal to him and his heirs forever, sub-
ject to the payment of two thirds of its income or clear profits to
my beloved wife Ann Rebecca D'Oysey for and during the
term of her natural life - I hereby nominate my said beloved
wife Executrix and my Son Charles William D'Oysey, my nephew
Doctor Joseph Glover, my friends John Fraser, B. F. Denkin and
Alexander Biny, Executors of this my last Will and Testament,
with full power to settle all the affairs of my Estate, and I do
hereby give unto my said Executors by and with the consent
of my Son Charles W. D'Oysey full power to make Sale of any
part or parts of my Estate for the purpose of paying my debts or
such other purpose as they may deem expedient. In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hands and Seal this sixth day
of February in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hun-
dred and nineteen.
