Whereas the late Mrs Sarah Filbair by her last will &
No 9 Testament bequeathed to me the said Granna certain property
consisting of negroes household furniture and so forth likewise
five hundred dollars and whereas the said Mrs Sarah Filbair
expressed in her will that in case I should depart this life
before her that the said property should go to my daughter
Hannah McBeth and her children and being willing to
carry the intentions of the said Mrs Filbair into effect altho
I have survived her I therefore do bequeath to my said daughter
Hannah McBeth and her children all the property and
money bequeathed me by my said friend and dear Mistress
Sarah Filbair and I refer to the will of my said Mistress
for an account of the said property so bequeathed me
and I leave Mr Tho Boone and Mr ^{my dear friend} Tom Harper Esqrs
to my last will and Testament and request them to act as such
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this
first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand
Eight hundred thirty one

that my Executors hereinafter named may sell such
of my property as they may think right to pay the
above named expences. After payment of my debts
funeral expences I give to my wife Mary Hood all
of my Estate as well real as personal for and during
the term of her natural life, and after her decease
all remaining of my Estate both personal and real
I give to my said wife for and during the term of her natural life
