

WILL OF
EDWARD MORTIMER

17 To I Edward Mortimer of the City of Charleston State
No 34 of South Carolina being in sound mind and memory
do make this my Last Will and Testament, to wit, I give
and bequeath unto my Daughter Charlotte Maria Adameon Bay-
kin all my right Title or Interest in or to certain neg-
roes given to me and to her Daughter Margaret, by John
Adameon, at our marriage to her and to her issue. Item
I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elisabeth H Ryan Two
thousand Dollars of my State Stock to be transfer'd to her
immediately after my decease. Item I will that at the mar-
riage or coming of age of each or any of my Children by
my Last wife Martha Mortimer that they be entitled to re-
ceive the Sum of Two thousand Dollars exclusive of the as-
sessment of Stock now in their names, which sum of Two thou-
sand Dollars shall be Considered as a proportion of my Es-
tate advanced to them. Item it is my Will that at the
coming of age marriage or death of my youngest Surviving
Child a compleat division of my Estate shall then be made
amongst my following Children namely, Elisabeth H Ryan,
May Haslehurst Edward C Mortimer Samuel H Mortimer, Aman-
da Mortimer Isabella H Mortimer, Thomas H Mortimer and
Jackson Mortimer which division shall be made in such
manner and by such means as my Executrix and Executors or
a majority of them may agree to, giving them full power
to sell or dispose of all or any part of my Lands and Ten-
ements and to convey and make Titles for the same. Lastly
I nominate and appoint my Daughter Elisabeth H Ryan Execu-
trix and my son Edward C Mortimer and Samuel H Mortimer
Executors to this my Last will and Testament. I Witnefs
whereof I have hereunto Set my Hand and Seal this 1st July
1826.

The following Codicil not admitted to Probate, & Recorded by request of family I Edward Mortimer of the City of Charleston do this 25th Nov^r 1826 make and publish this my Codicil to my Last Will & Testament in manner following that is to say, I give to my Sister Charlotte Coram an annuity of One hundred and Sixty Dollars to be paid her quarterly, that is to say Forty Dollars on each and every 1st days of January April July and October during her natural life-----
