EDWARD DARRELL

1870 } In the name of God Amen, I Edward Darrell of Charles-
New } ton South Carolina being of sound and disposing mind
memory and understanding do hereby make publish and declare
my last will & Testament as follows to wit In the first place
I give devise and bequeath to my Cousin Sims White the whole
of my wearing apparel and my Saddle & Bridle. In the second
place I will that all my just debts be paid as soon after my
decease as possible and for that purpose I hereby instruct
my Executor to sell as many of my Bank Shares as may be neces-
sary the balance left after the Settlements of my Debts to-
gether with the remainder of the shares if any there be I give
devise & bequeath to my Cousins Amelia Land Sarah H Lequeux
to them and their heirs forever. Item I give devise & bequeath
to my dear Aunt Anne H Darrell my House & Lot in George Street
Charleston for and during the term of her natural Life and
after her death to my Cousin Amelia Lois & Sarah H Lequeux
their heirs and assigns forever. Lastly I hereby constitute &
appoint my dearly beloved Uncle John White Executor to this my
last Will and Testament earnestly beseeching him to accept
the Trust. Witnefs my Hand and Seal at Pineville in State afore-
said this first day of August A.D. 1827
