& her issue, for his sole use during his life, & after his death, she the
said Nelly & her issue shall be sold at public sale, & the proceeds
arising therefrom shall be equally divided between my daughter
Betty & her children. Item, I will & bequeath to my grandson William
Son of my daughter Betty, all my Stock of cattle, Hogs, Poultry & House-
hold furniture (excepted aforesaid) to his own sole use. Lastly, I hereby
constitute and appoint Mr. Thomas Corbitt & Mr. Isaac Ball, Executors
to this my last Will & Testament, Revoking all other Wills by me made.

of said year.
