ELEANOR SIMONS

17 T.^o State of South Carolina Whereas by a certain In-
 No 9 denture tripartite between myself of the first
 part, my beloved Husband Keating Simons of the Second &
 John Ball of St Johns Parish in the State aforesaid of
 the third part bearing date the 26th September 1793 and
 purporting to be a marriage Settlement between my said
 husband and me, all and Singular the property therein men-
 tioned are held by the said John Ball in the event of my
 dying before my Husband in trust for such persons as by
 my Last Will and testament I should give and bequeath the
 same to, and it is also therein Stipulated that notwith-
 standing my being Married I should be at Liberty to make
 and Execute such Last Will and testament; Now in pursu-
 ance of the said power I do hereby make and publish this
 my Last Will and testament hereby revoking and making all
 former Wills by me at any time heretofore made. First I
 give and bequeath to my beloved husband all the property
 that I pofsefsed previous to our marriage consisting of ne-
 groes with the ifsue and increase of the females, Household
 furniture plate bonds and notes as particularly described
 in the Schedule of the above mentioned Settlement to him
 and his heirs forever. Secondly I nominate and appoint my
 Said Husband Sole Executor to this my Last Will & testament
 In Witnefs whereof I have hereunto Subscribed my name and
 affixed my Seal this thirtieth day of October 1811.
