I, Elizabeth Ashe of Charleston, being of sound and disposing mind and memory and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs whilst I have strength and capacity so to do, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and making void all former Wills by me at any time heretofore made. and as to my worldly Estate I dispose of the same as followeth - Imprimis. It is my Will and desire that all my just debts and funeral Expenses should be paid by my Executors herein after named, as soon after my death as may be convenient. I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Eliza Daniel Legare, previous four Shares of the South Carolina Bank Stock amounting to Four hundred Dollars and also one hundred Dollars to be paid to her by my Executors herein after named as

four after my decease and I give and bequeath
unto my grand daughter Mary Daniel Toomer all my share in
the Union Bank Stock which I have. Item I give and bequeath
unto my Son Doctor Daniel Legare, five hundred and twenty Dollars
to be paid out of my Estate as for an account and for not
giving him more of my Estate I wish him to consider the fol-
lowing reasons, as the only motives which have governed
me in making the provisions of this my last Will, to wit. that
he has received considerably more of the Estate of his Grandfather
and Father than his two Sisters, and his Sister Ann Legare
will be left a female unable to exert herself for a livelihood
and without the experience or direct interest of any male in
her concerns. Item It is my will and desire and I do hereby
require of my Executors hereinafter named to sell in the most
advantageous manner, my House and Lot with the out
Buildings in Lombol Street together with all my negroes
and to divide the proceeds thereof between my two daughters
Ann Legare and Mary Daniel Toomer as follows, to wit,
my said daughter Ann Legare receiving in the division two
thousand five hundred Dollars more than her Sister for the
reasons aforesaid. and it is my Will and desire that the said
Sale and division should be made by my said Executors as
soon after my death as may be expedient. Item I give and

reasons aforesaid. and it is my Will and desire that the said
Sale and division should be made by my said Executors as
soon after my death as may be expedient. Item. I give and
bequeath unto my said daughter, Ann Legare my horse and
chaise to her, forever, to be delivered to her by my Executors
herein after named, as soon after my death as practicable.

Item. It is my Will and desire that all my Hounhold and Kitchen
furniture, plate, apparel and Jewellery should be equally divided
between my two daughters Ann Legare and Mary D. Loomer
by my Executors hereinafter named as soon after my death
as may be proper. Item. As to the rest and residue of my

Estate real and personal I will it to be divided equally be-
tween my said daughters Ann Legare and Mary Daniel
Loomer to them forever. And lastly I hereby nominate con-
stitute and appoint Doctor Daniel Legare and Doctor Anthony
V. Loomer, ^{Executors} with my daughter Ann Legare Executors of this

my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have
