being in health of body and sound and disposing memory
and understanding Plead before for the same. Do make public
and declare this my last Will and Testament in manner and
form following, that is to say, I deprive, I will and direct all
my just debts and funeral expenses to be paid as soon as may be
convenient after my decease. Item I give and bequeath unto
my grand-daughter Elizabeth Vanderhorst Bonneau for and
during her natural life and at her death then to the lawfully
begotten issue of her Body living at the time of her death a negro
girl about fifteen or sixteen years of age to be selected or purchased
for her my said grand-daughter from my Estate within six
months after my decease together with the future issue and
increase from that time of such female slave and my gold watch
and chain but should my grand-daughter Elizabeth Vanderhorst
Bonneau die without leaving lawfully begotten issue of her Body

152. alive at the time of her death then the said female slave and
her issue and increase and my said Gold Watch and
shall return to and be a part of the rest residue and
remainder of my estate. Item I give devise and bequeath
all the rest residue and remainder of my Estate real and
personal whatsoever and wheresoever unto my dear Son
Arnoldus Bonneau his heirs and assigns forever and should
my said Son Arnoldus Bonneau die before me leaving
lawfully begotten issue living at the time of my death then
and in that case I give devise and bequeath all the said
rest residue and remainder of my Estate real and per-
sonal unto the said lawfully begotten Issue of my said
Son Arnoldus Bonneau if but one then to that one his
heirs or assigns absolutely and forever and if more than
then to them their heirs and assigns absolutely and forever
Share and Share alike as tenants in common the Issue of
any of the deceased Issue of my said Son Arnoldus Bonneau
taking together only the Share to which the parent or parents
would if alive have been entitled. Lastly I do hereby con-
stitute nominate and appoint my Son Arnoldus Bonneau
sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament and
Guardian of the Person and property of ^{my} Grand-daughter
Elizabeth Vanderhorst.
