Item and I do hereby make and appoint my dear and beloved Wife sole Executrix to this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and annulling all other Wills heretofore made and constituting and confirming this. Given under my hand this 10th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one 1801.

form following, and first of all I recommend
my soul unto God who gave it and my
body I commit to the ground to be buried
in a decent Christian burial at the dis-
cretion of my Executors hereafter named,
and now as to settling of my worldly goods,
which it hath pleased Almighty God to bless
me with, I will dispose as follows, and first I
will that my funeral charges be paid out of
my Estate by my Executors out of my Estate
with my lawful debts which I owe to any.
Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved
Grand daughter, Ann Cook the daughter
of William Cook, the tract of land whereon
I now live containing one hundred acres,
butting and bounding to the West on lands
belonging to the Estate of Robert Dorrill
to the North West on lands belonging to Mon-
den Weston, to ~~the~~ East on lands belonging
to William Dorrill, to her and her heirs for
ever, and to be delivered to her by my Exec-
utors at the age of eighteen years, Item I
give and bequeath unto my beloved Grand

daughter Ann Cook two Cows and Calves with
their Increase, together with my bed and furni-
ture. And lastly I nominate constitute and appoint
my beloved friends Nicholas Penning and Joseph
Dorrill to be my Executors to this my last Will
and Testament revoking and making null
and void all former Wills and Testaments or
bequeaths ratifying this and no other to be my
last Will and Testament, whereunto I have set
my hand and affixed my seal this twenty
third day of March 1788.
