No 23 Elizabeth Fraser of Charleston being weak in body but thankful that I am sound in mind and memory do make this my last will in manner following I give to my Niece Mary Winthrop for and during her natural life my moiety or half of the house and lot at the corner of Orange and Chadd Streets as also all and singular my personal estate consisting of stock and bonds and from & after her death or in the event of her not surviving me I give and devise the same to my Nieces Jane Elizabeth and Ann Winthrop in manner following that is to say to them equally during their joint lives and from and after the death of either of them to the survivor successively and to the longest liver of them absolutely. I hereby confirm the gift to my brother Charles Fraser of the Silver Castles now in his possession, and hereby appoint him and my nephew Doctor Henry Winthrop executors of this my last will. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this Seventeenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty six
