Jenny with her future issue and increase, I also give & bequeath
unto Esther Baker Blackwoods the Daughter of Thomas Blackwood
of the City of Charleston and State aforesaid, during and for
the term of her Natural life and at her death to the Children of
her body Lawfully begotten share and share alike. The following
Negro Slaves viz. Ann, Ruth, Sarah, Kate, John and
to hold the aforesaid Negroes with the issue and increase of
the females unto the said Esther Baker Blackwoods her
heirs and assigns forever. I also give and bequeath to Mary
Blackwoods Daughter of Thomas Blackwoods, during her
Natural life and at her death to the heirs of her body Lawfully
begotten my Negro Woman named Mary and together with
her Daughter named Susannah with their future issue and
increase unto the said Mary Blackwoods her heirs & assigns
forever I also give and bequeath unto Sarah Blackwoods

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humbly desiring and making void all former and other Wills
by me at any time heretofore made. Imprimis I give & bequeath
unto Mrs Mary Baker the Wife of Francis Baker for & during
the term of her Natural life and in case of her death to the Children
of her Body Lawfully begotten, one Negro Woman named
Jenny with her future issue and increase, I also give & bequeath
unto Esther Baker Blackwoods the Daughter of Thomas Blackwood
of the City of Charleston and State aforesaid, during and for
the term of her Natural life and at her death to the Children of
her body Lawfully begotten share and share alike. The following
Negro Slaves viz. Mary. Ruth. Sarah. Kate. Jo. have and
to hold the aforesaid Negroes with the issue and increase of
the females unto the said Esther Baker Blackwoods her
heirs and assigns forever. I also give and bequeath to Mary
Blackwoods Daughter of Thomas Blackwoods, during her
Natural life and at her death to the heirs of her body Lawfully
begotten my Negro Woman named Mary and together with
her Daughter named Susannah with their future issue and
increase unto the said Mary Blackwoods her heirs & assigns
forever I also give and bequeath unto Sarah Blackwoods
Daughter of Thomas Blackwood during her Natural life
and after her death to the heirs of her body Lawfully

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My Negro Woman named Sue together with her future
and increase unto the said Sarah Blackwood her heirs and assigns
forever. And it is my Will and pleasure that either of the within
named devisees Daughters of Thomas Blackwood should die
without issue then the negroes left to them by the Will together with
their issue and increase to revert to their Father Thomas Blackwood
to be bestowed by him on his other surviving Children in such
manner as he may think advisable. I also give and bequeath
to Harriet Blackwood wife of Thomas Blackwood my Negro Woman
named Rose together with her future issue and increase. As well as
all and singular the articles of household furniture Bedding plate &c
I may be possessed of unto the said Harriet Blackwood her heirs
and assigns forever. Whereas in consideration of the assistance received
from my friend Thomas Blackwood in procuring my negroes
wrongfully detained in the State of Georgia. I several years ago gave
him my Negro Man named September. but lest any doubt should arise
with regards to the Validity of this gift I now confirm the same and
give and bequeath to the said Thomas Blackwood the said Negro
fellow named September to himself and heirs forever. And I
further bequeath to Thomas Blackwood his Successors and assigns
for the use of himself and family. The whole residue of my Estate
of whatever nature or description it may be for his and their use
and behoof forever. In Testimony whereof I do hereunto set my hand and Affix my Seal

for the use of himself and family. The whole residue of my Estate
of whatever nature or description it may be for his and their use
and behoof forever. Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint
the aforementioned Thomas Blackwood Executor of this my
last Will and Testament. In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this twentieth day of October in the year of our
Lord One thousand eight hundred and eleven. Day of Charleston
