pg 47 I Francis Good of Charleston Neck in the district
and State aforesaid being of sound mind memory and under-
standing do make and declare this my Last Will and Testament
in manner and form following that is to say. I give devise
and bequeath all my real and personal estate of what nature
or Kind Soever to my beloved Wife Mary Magdalena Good dur-
ing her natural life and after her death I give devise and
bequeath one fifth part of all my Said real and personal
Estate to my Son Peter Good to him and his heirs forever,
Provided always neverthelefs that should my said son Peter
Good die without leaving lawful issue that then and in that
event the said one fifth part shall go to the children of
my daughter Catharine Pell Boutan formerly Catharine Good
share and share alike to them and their heirs forever I
give devise and bequeath one other fifth part of my said
real and personal Estate unto my Executor hereinafter named
his Executors administrators and assigns for ever In Trust
to and for the sole Seperate use and benefit and behoof of
my daughter Catharine Pell Boutan formerly Catharine Good
as aforesaid for & during the term of her natural life free
from the controul debts contracts & engagements of her
present or any future husband and from & immediately after
her death then in trust for such child or children ~~or chil-~~
~~dren~~ as she may leave absolutely and forever. I give devise
and bequeath one other fifth part of my said real and per-
sonal Estate to Francis Duke and Mary Madelena Martin his
Wife to them and their heirs forever. I give devise and
bequeath one other fifth part of my Said real and personal
Estate to Henry Rumph and Veronia Martin his Wife to them
and their heirs for ever I give devise and bequeath one oth-
er fifth part of my Said real and personal estate to John
Jacob Martin to him and his heirs for ever Lastly I nomi-
nate and appoint my friend Peter B. Boutan (the uncle of

the husband of the aforesaid Catharine Fell Boutan formerly Catharine Good) in whom I have full and ample confidence the sole executor of this my last Will and testament hereby revoking all such will or wills as I may have heretofore made and do declare this to be my Last Will and testament. Given under my hand and Seal this third day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty Six and in the fiftieth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.--
