I give devise and bequeath one other fifth part of my said real and personal Estate to Francis Duke and Mary Madelena Martin his Wife to them and their heirs forever. I give devise and bequeath one other fifth part of my Said real and personal Estate to Henry Rumph and Veronia Martin his Wife to them and their heirs for ever I give devise and bequeath one other fifth part of my Said real and personal estate to John Jacob Martin to him and his heirs for ever Lastly I nominate and appoint my friend Peter B. Boutan (the uncle of

the husband of the aforesaid Catharine Pell Boutan formerly Catharine Good) in whom I have full and ample confidence the sole executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all such will or wills as I may have heretofore made and do declare this to be my Last will and testament. Given under my hand and Seal this third day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty Bix and in the fiftieth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.

Signed scaled and delivered in the presence of us who in the presence of each other and at the request of the said Francis Good have Signed our names as Witnefess thereto.

This Will was again proved on the 4 January 1841. It having been discovered that the Testator had died but a short time before the above date and this will had been recorded by mistake.
