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In the Name of God Amen, I Francis Huger
of Christ Church Parish, State of South Carolina, my
just and lawful debts being duly paid, do by this my
last Will and Testament, bequeath and leave the
whole of my Estate both real and personal to be equal-
ly divided share and share alike, between my Wife
Mary Huger and between my daughter Ann Huger
her heirs assigns &c. Item at the death and demise
of my said Wife c^W Mary Huger, I do bequeath and Will
the share of my Wife the said c^W Mary Huger, do de-
volve and become the property of my said daughter
Ann Huger her heirs assigns &c. Item at the death
and demise of my said daughter Ann Huger leav-
ing no Issue I do then Will and bequeath the whole
of my Estate both real and personal be equally divi-
ded share and share alike between the Children of my
late brother Isaac Huger and between the Children
of my Aunt Mary Parry, In like manner I do leave
and bequeath a legacy of ten pounds per annum un-
to Maria Williams brought up formerly at my place

176. station in St. Johns Parish. Lastly by this my last Will and Testament I do annul make void revoke entire all former Wills whatever, which have been heretofore by me made, and I do hereby my last Will and Testament appoint as Executors to this my last Will and Testament M^r. I give devise and bequeath unto my friend Frederick Rohne of Charleston Merchant all that my lot of land situate lying and being at the corner of Pitt and Wentworth Streets in Charleston aforesaid which was purchased from Edward Lightwood with the hereditaments and appurtenance thereunto belonging and to his heirs and assigns for ever, on the condition that he pays to my Estate the sum of one thousand pounds sterling money immediately or soon after my decease the buildings and improvements on the said lot having been erected and made at the ex-
