Item I give to my Daughter Celia the use of two Cows and one yearling during her Life and at her death to her heirs for ever Item I give to my daughter Lucinda the use of one Cow and Calf and two heiffers during her Life and at her death to go to her heirs forever. Item I give to my daughter Harriet the use of two Cows and Calfs and one heiffer during her Life and at her death to go to her heirs forever. Item I give to my Daughter Martha the use of four Cows and Calfs and one heiffer during her Life and at her death to go to her heirs forever. Item I give to my son Levi one Cow and Calf and at the death of his mother I give him all the remaining part of my plantation to him and his heirs forever. Item I give unto my loving Wife Mary Sineath during her Life all the remaining part of my plantation all the remainder of my Cattle all my Stock of Hogs and horses all my Household & Kitchen furniture and all my implements

Lastly I do hereby nominate & appoint my brother in Law John Manning gaq Executor of this my Last will and testament. In witners Thereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Twenty minth day of January One thousand Eight hundred and Seventeen.
