FRANCIS SINEATH

17 T<sup>s</sup> South Carolina Horry District. In the Name of  
N. 10 God amen, I Francis Sineath of Saint Stephens  
Parish in the State aforesaid Farmer being sick in body  
but of sound mind and memory & Knowing that it is appoint-  
ed for all men once to die, do therefore Constitute & or-  
testament. First I recommend my Soul to be my Last Will and  
it in hopes of a Joyful Resurrection, and as to what worldly  
goods the Lord hath blefseed me with I give & dispose of as  
follows. Item I give to my daughter Elizabeth Hughes that  
part of my Plantation where she is now settled to her and  
her heirs forever, the line to run from the back line of  
my land along the north edge of Bulls big pond, and from  
thence along a small drain in the pine land to the front  
line. Item I give to my daughter Mary Wait the use of two  
Cows and yearlings during her Life which is now in her  
possefsion, and at her death to her heirs forever. Item  
I give to my Daughter Celia the use of two Cows and one  
yearling during her Life and at her death to her heirs for  
ever Item I give to my daughter Lucinda the use of one  
Cow and Calf and two heiffers during her Life and at her  
death to go to her heirs forever. Item I give to my daugh-  
ter Harriet the use of two Cows and Calfs and one heiffer  
during her Life and at her death to go to her heirs for-  
ever. Item I give to my Daughter Martha the use of four  
Cows and Calfs and one heiffer during her Life and at her  
death to go to her heirs forever. Item I give to my son  
Levi one Cow and Calf and at the death of his mother I give  
him all the remaining part of my plantation to him and his  
heirs forever. Item I give unto my loving Wife Mary Sineath  
during her Life all the remaining part of my plantation all  
the remainder of my Cattle all my Stock of Hogs and horses  
all my Household & Kitchen furniture and all my implements

of Husbandry &c &c to be kept together for the Support & Maintenance of herself and my unmarried Children and at the death of my wife Mary all the personal property given to her is to be equally divided among my Daughters Mary Lucinda Celia Harriet and Martha and if any of my Legatees should die without issue then their part or parts to be equally divided among ~~xx~~ the Surviving heirs. Lastly I do hereby nominate & appoint my brother in Law John Manning Esq Executor of this my Last Will and testament. In Witnefs Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Twenty ninth day of January One thousand Eight hundred and Seventeen.
